

# Quick action saves historic Hadley building from fire -Earhart Building dates to 1902

Hadley and Elba Township firefighters were called out Wednesday morning to the Earhart Building in downtown Hadley.



HADLEY — Late Wednesday morning, workers at Warren Design in the historic Earhart Building at 3529 Hadley Road in downtown Hadley noticed a smell and wandered out to investigate. They spotted smoke rolling out from under the eaves at the front of the building. The windows were charred black and they were hot to the touch. "You could feel the heat," said Bob Warren. He wasted no time dialing 911.

Nancy Kott arrived at her office in the building just in time to hand the keys to the front door over to the arriving firefighters. She runs the International Morse Preservation Society in the facility, serving a worldwide membership of 15,000 in the FISTS CW Club.

Firefighters from Hadley and Elba Townships responded so quickly that the fire never got a chance to spread. They doused the fire with 300 gallons of water. Metamora Township Fire Department was also dispatched for a tanker assist but quickly canceled.

The cause of the fire is as yet undetermined, but the apparent source of the blaze was tossed out to the sidewalk — a combination printer copier machine that likely had an electrical short.

Although firefighters stopped the fire in its tracks and there was no structural damage, Kott's office up front sustained damages that will render it unusable for a while. The office sustained smoke and heat damage. The ceilings had to be torn down to ensure that no fire spread there.

Kott sadly surveyed the damages with her husband at her side. "My stuff is a mess in there from the water and smoke," said Kott. "It's overwhelming. Estimated damage is around \$25,000 for contents and repairs to the office walls and ceilings. Despite the damage, everyone was happy that there were no injuries in the incident.

Kott plans to regroup and get back to the business of the Morse Code club in the Earhart Building office. "I love this building. It has such a history. I enjoy being in here."

"Hadley and Elba firefighters spent a lot of extra time to make sure there was no fire extension to the rest of the building as well as removing smoke from the facility," said Hadley Township Fire Chief Kurt Nass.

Other tenants of the building suffered no damage. Warren Design does custom metal work in space toward the rear of the building. Building owner Jim Hebb also runs a custom staircase business in the the last 20 years at the building. The bowstring construction makes for a risky fire attack.

We've been extremely lucky in each instance. The construction itself is associated with killing a lot of firefighters due to collapse nationwide. We are very selective and aware of the dangers to our personnel when we respond to this building," said Nass.

Other tenants of the building suffered no damage. Warren Design does custom metal work in space toward the rear of the building. Building owner Jim Hebb also runs a custom staircase business in the facility. He was pleased with the fire department response.

"They did a fine job," said Hebb of the firefighters. "Everybody's safe."

The Earhart Building dates back more than 100 years. Hadley Township historian Kent Copeman says that the building was originally built by Murray Phelps for a trucking company. It was later known as the Neu Garage and then as Earhart's Garage. The cement block and heavy-timber building has stood the test of time. Nass said that this was the third fire in the last 20 years at the building. The bowstring construction makes for a risky fire attack. "We've en extremely lucky in each instance. The construction itself is associated with killing a lot of firefighters due to collapse nationwide. We are very selective and aware of the dangers to our personnel when we respond to this building," said Nass.

Nass noted that the quick action of the Warren Design workers was critical, saying, "If the other occupant hadn't discovered the smoke the building would have probably been lost."



WZ8C surveysthe damage to the ceiling which made quite a mess after

being torn down to check for "hot spots." Heavy wet insulation covered the floor, cabinets and desks.



# On The Cover - The FISTS QSL Bureau

We are very grateful to the QSL Bureau and appreciate the fine job they are doing. The Bureau is one more example of our volunteers "behind the scenes" who may not get credit for all they do to make FISTS a premiere CW club. If you hear them on the air, be sure to say Thanks!

The following is a synopsis of the Bureau by Stan Reas, K4UK

Since November 1997, members of the Franklin County Amateur Radio Club of Virginia have provided the World Wide QSL service for the International Morse Preservation Society, better known as the FISTS CW Club.

Presently the eight members include:

Riley, K4ORD - handles the "1" calls Dick, K1HEL - handles the "2" calls Harry, KA3NZR - handles the "3" calls Stan, K4UK - handles the "4", "VE" & "DX" calls

Frank, K4HOA - handles the "5" & "8" calls

JJ, W4EIE - handles the "6" calls Buddy, W4YE - handles the "7" & "0" calls

Fran, KI4ZND - handles the "9" calls

In nearly 13 years the Bureau has handled 400,145 cards. Until this year, members were requested to send SASEs to the Bureau.

On January 1, 2010 we began a New Approach and don't require members to send SASE's but simply provide us cash or

checks or stamps and we will prepare envelopes with the "Forever" stamp on each of them.

The envelopes will be #10 business size and the "Forever" stamp on it will handle one ounce which is normally 7 cards. We will print out labels per the address that Nancy Kott, WZ8C, has sent us that we have in our members list.

Based on present postage rates the amount deducted for each envelope will be 50 cents. This covers the cost of the envelope, the label and the "Forever" stamp.

For those members who have previously donated money or stamps to the QSL Bureau, we will use these donations to make envelopes when we use their last one to mail cards.

We will continue doing that until the value of the donation is used up.

The Bureau web site <www.fistsburo.org> provides information about who uses the Bureau and the status of cards and envelopes we have on hand for them. The "Bureau Use Search" provides a fast method to determine whether a member uses the Bureau or whether the member QSL's direct only or whether the member does not QSL at all.





Photo Below Right: - The new coastal vessel "BRITT ANN"






